06/15/2019	Boulder Beer Chase The purpose of the event is to promote and celebrate running and the NoCo craft brewery industry and help support local non-profit organizations through paid volunteer opportunities. This is a 6-person, 12-leg relay where each leg is between ~3-6 miles. Each team has only 1 runner on the course at any point in time and teams are starting in 'waves' every 20-40 minutes in groups of 10-20. A total of 90-125 runners are expected to pass through Boulder County during a 6-7 hour period, but including inactive runners there will be 600-750 total participants. No street/sidewalk/trail/path are closed for this race and all participants are to obey all traffic and pedestrian laws. An overview of the entire course from Ft. Collins to Boulder is attached along with legs 7, 8, 10, 11 and 12 which are in (or are partially in) Boulder County. Additionally, the site layout for the exchange location at the Coors Grain Elevator and at Bootstrap Brewery (in Niwot) are included. An estimated 3,000 cyclists and 650 volunteers will participate in the 2-day, 150-mile ride that begins and ends at Front Range Community College in Westminster, and overnights in Ft. Collins. Colorado State University will play host to the cyclists on Saturday night in Ft. Collins. Cyclists will be afforded an optional century route at the end of Day 1. Cyclists will travel on road and mountain bikes as well as a few tandems. The riders will be supported by rest stops every 10 - 16 miles as well as support vehicles (SAG) for the duration of the ride. Additional route services will include marshals, medics, ham operators, staff, and ride officials.
