In 2024, this will be the third edition of Ned Gravel. We are keeping many components the same as well as expanding the aspects that make Ned Gravel a unique cycling event. Cycling has been a homogenous sport for a long time and we are a part of dismantling that and attracting typically disadvantaged groups to cycling. That is why we are offering early and discounted entry to women, athletes of color and non-binary individuals. In addition we will be creating a fund to help pay for entries for people who may not be able to afford it. By reducing barriers to entry for marginalized groups we are hoping to have the most diverse gravel bike race in the country. We also want to be environmentally conscious as possible with the ultimate goal of being zero waste. Our initial efforts include a zero cup event, trash/recycling/compost receptacles at start/finish and all aid stations, course sweepers making sure no trash is accidentally left on the course and option for participants to pay to offset their carbon footprint while traveling to the event.

The race is being planned for 7/13/2024. The race is made up of 4 course options offering four distance options; 20 mile, 50 mile, 70 mile and 116 mile. The start/finish will be in Nederland with each loop branching out from there. The long course will start at 5AM, and complete a 47 mile loop which is mainly in Gilpin County and then the 70 mile loop which is all in Boulder County. The 70 mile race will start at 7AM and will complete just the Boulder County loop. Then the 50 mile race will start at 7:30AM and finally the 20 mile course starts at 8:00am. During that time we are also hoping to include a small kids race/bike safety rodeo that will take place around the start/finish area and will be free and open to all kids, even if their parents are not racing.

We are applying for a permit for 1000 participants and expect to sell all 1000 spots. With 1000 participants we would anticipate an additional 500 spectators for a total max of around 1500 people.

Parking in Nederland for any event is always a challenge. We will strongly encourage carpooling and will find ways to incentivize that. We are utilizing in town parking this year and have approved permits for Barker Reservoir, Nederland Community Center and Nederland Elementary School.

We are not requesting any closure of county roads. For a full course description see our Traffic Control Plan in our Operations Plan for maps, links and description.

We are concurrently submitting our Town of Nederland Permits, Colorado Highway Patrol and Gilpin County Permit requests.
