<p>Bike MS, Colorado's Ride 2018 will take place June 23 and 24, 2018. Bike MS is a charity ride benefiting those living with multiple sclerosis. An estimated 3,000 cyclists and 650 volunteers will participate in the 2-day, 150-mile ride that begins and ends at Front Range Community College in Westminster, and overnights in Ft. Collins. Colorado State University will play host to the cyclists on Saturday night in Ft. Collins. Cyclists will be afforded an optional century route at the end of Day 1. Cyclists will travel on road and mountain bikes as well as a few tandems. The riders will be supported by rest stops every 10 - 16 miles as well as support vehicles (SAG) for the duration of the ride. Additional route services will include marshals, medics, ham operators, staff, and ride officials. Originating in Europe, Haute Route is excited to bring the event to several locations in the United States in 2018.</p> <p>April 20-22 San Francisco, California May 18-20 Asheville, North Carolina June 23-29 Colorado Sept 14-16 Cedar City, Utah</p> <p>Haute Route prides itself on bringing unique, challenging courses along with professional support often only seen at the largest professional cycling races in the world. Organizers work closely with local agencies to provide safe riding conditions for all riders. The event maintains "Rules of the Road" out on course, unless local law enforcement provides a neutral controlled start to help the ride exit town safely with minimal disruptions to traffic. Once out on course, riders will encounter time sections where a timing mat will be placed and supervised at the beginning and end of each section. Typically the timed sections are on sustained climbs to more easily coordinate riders and traffic management.
